Your pass must be visible to a Pentastic Jazz Ambassador at all times and is required for entrance to the venues and for use of the free shuttle service. Purchasing the passes during the Festival is easy. You can purchase them at the registration table at the Trade & Convention Centre, which operates as our headquarters.

Rising star, Dane Bateman, a local singer-songwriter, will be performing with Jolo Mason on Friday, Sept. 5th at 9pm in Bourbon St. Festival goers are sure to love his unique style. Dane is a storyteller that draws from personal experiences and his sound is characterized by a mix of traditional and modern country - his warm and raspy voice captures the essence of the lyrics he's written. Dane released his newest single "Whiskey Promises" on May 1st to rave reviews.

Since breaking into the Canadian country music scene eight years ago, JoJo has been on a continued mission to find his own unique voice and connect with fans through his music. With an incredible six Top 10 tracks, he has earned a CRIA Gold-certification for his single "Better On You" and accumulated over 50 million career streams to date. He is a multiple Canadian Country Music Association (CCMA) Award nominee, earned the coveted title of Entertainer of the Year (2022) via the BC Country Music Association Awards, and won BreakOut West's Country Artist of the Year Award (2023). In addition to his talent as a clarinet virtuoso, Dave is also an ace "pumpin' piano man" in the Jerry Lee tradition. Hal has played with many of the best traditional jazz and swing bands in the U.S., but also enjoys playing old school Rockabilly style drums. Look for a room full of happy Rockabilly fans and a dance floor with a "Whole Lotta Shakin' Goin' On" and you have found the Memphis Speed Kings!
